There are many challenges in increasing the blood donors:  • Lack of awareness about the need of blood donation and its importance.  • Myths and wrong perceptions about the blood donations.  • Fear about the post blood donation effects.  • Matching the blood properties' becomes an issue with rare blood groups.			

Practice	Blood donation has been considered as the most auspicious of donations, which not only inculcates the values towards caring others but also provides substantial support to humankind otherwise not possible with any wealthy contributions. Keeping in mind the central idea of inculcating service to the nation, "Blood donation" activity was initiated in the year 2013-14. 


